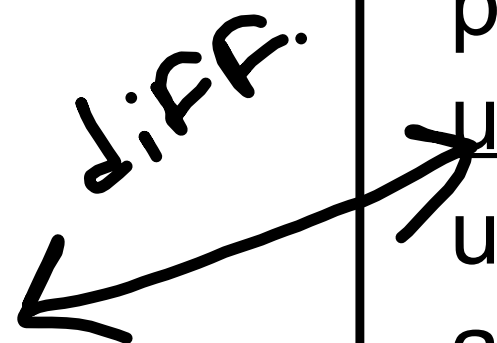

Jesus offers himself

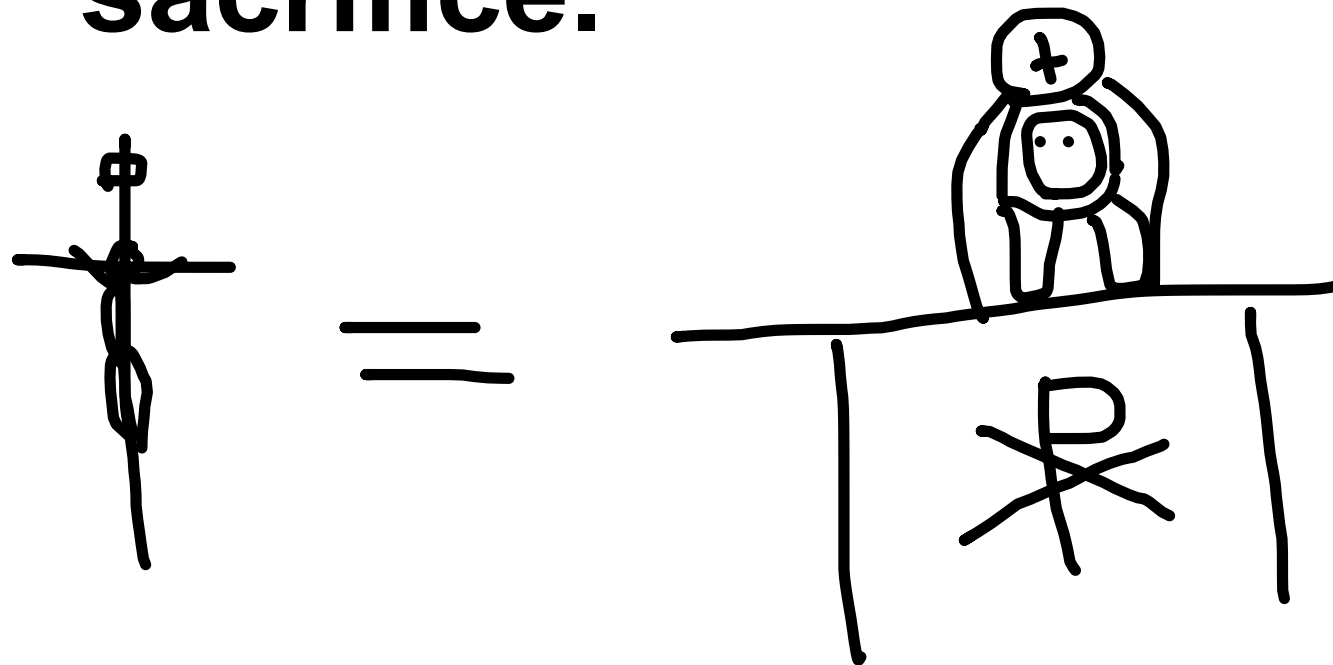
Jesus offers himself through the priest

III. Liturgy of the Eucharist

A. Eucharistic Prayer

1) **Preface:** "It is truly right and just, our duty and salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks...."

2) **Sanctus:** "Holy, Holy, Holy"

3) **Epiclesis:** "Make holy, therefore, these gifts, we pray, by sending down your Spirit upon them like the dewfall, so that they may become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ."

4) **Consecration/Institution**

Narrative:

This is my Body which will be given up for you... Take this, all of you, and drink from it: for this is the chalice of my Blood... Do this in memory of me.

5) **Memorial Acclamation:**

(Mystery of Faith) "We proclaim, Your death, O Lord, and profess Your Resurrection, until You come in Glory"

6) **Anamnesis:** Therefore, as we celebrate the memorial of his Death and Resurrection, **we offer you**, Lord, the Bread of life and the Chalice of salvation, giving thanks that you have held us worthy to be in your presence and minister to you

7) **Intercessions:** Remember, Lord, your Church, spread throughout the world, and bring her to the fullness of charity, together with N. our Pope and N. our Bishop and all the clergy.

8) **Doxology:** Through Him, with Him, and in Him, O God almighty Father, in the Unity of the Holy Spirit...

9) **Amen**
