Gen. 1:1-2 1) The beginning of time and God is creating the world. 2) Sweeping over the waters.

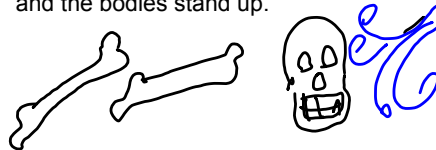


Gen. 3:1-13

1) Adam and Eve sin against God. 2) God comes in the breeze 3)



Ezekiel 37:1-14 1) Valley of death (spooky, scary skeletons). 2) Holy Spirit passes as a wind through the bones. Flesh comes back and the bodies stand up.



Luke 1:26-38. 1) Annunciation of Gabriel to the Blessed Mother. 2) Holy Spirit comes upon her (overshadows).



Luke 3:21-22

1) Jesus is baptized by John the baptist.
2) Holy Spirit descends as a dove (peace, and life coming into our own Baptism).

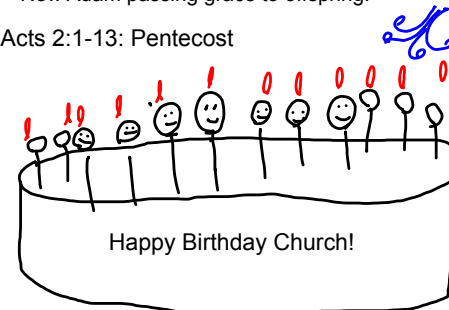


John 20:19-23

Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit (breath of life) on the apostles giving them the power to forgive sins (recreate man in God's image). New Adam passing grace to offspring.

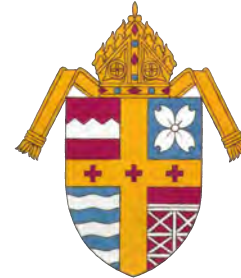

CHILD OF GOD

It roots us more deeply as children of God which makes us cry, "Abba, Father!"

It increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us: wisdom, counsel, understanding, knowledge, fortitude, piety, fear of the Lord.

EFFECT 2

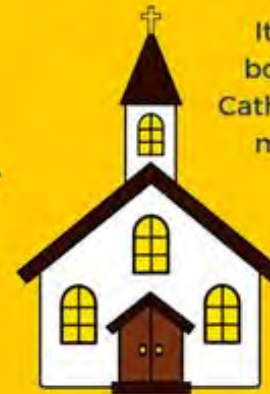
CLOSER TO CHRIST

It unites us more firmly to our Savior Jesus Christ.

FULLY CATHOLIC

It renders our bond with the Catholic Church more perfect.

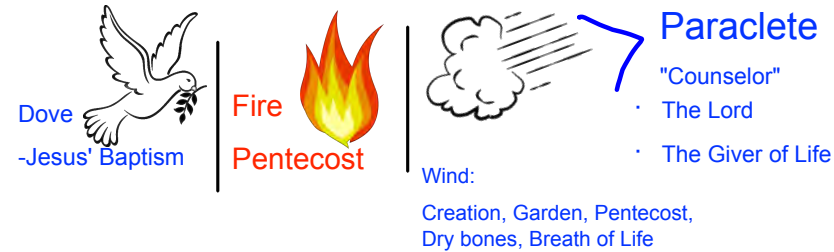

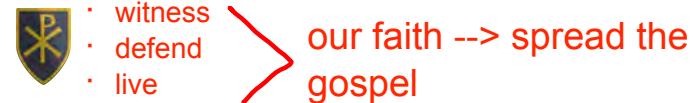
Sacrament of Confirmation

Matter, form, minister

Effects: indelible seal, marking us as mature Christians in the faith, increases grace

- confirmation strengthens us to: CCC 1303



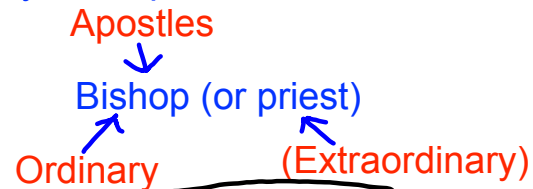
Matter: Sacred Chrism or Myron (East)

The bishop blesses **three kinds of holy oil** for his whole diocese, at the Chrism Mass (usually Holy Thursday). Holy oils are kept in the **ambry** in each church.



Oil symbolizes grace:

- cleanses
- heals
- strengthens
- helps escape a grip

Oil of the Sick

Used for Anointing the Sick

Sacred Chrism

Used for Confirmation, Holy Orders, and consecrating altars, churches

Oil of the Catechumens

Used to anoint after Baptism symbolizing a share in Christ's offices: priest, prophet, king

7 "Gifts" of the Spirit

Isaiah 11:2-3



- Sustain moral life
- Complete and perfect virtues
- Allows us to be students of the Holy Spirit
- Like metal in fire, to become more like Christ



Helps us to see everything in life in relation to God and eternity, to know his plan for men **Knowledge**



Inspires us to worship God and love him as Father, love neighbor, "reverence"

Piety



Helps us to make correct decisions about

God's will, "right judgment"

Counsel



Helps us see that the world is a temporary place, heaven is our true home, see things as God sees; not foolish

Wisdom



Shows us evil of sin and helps us to desire

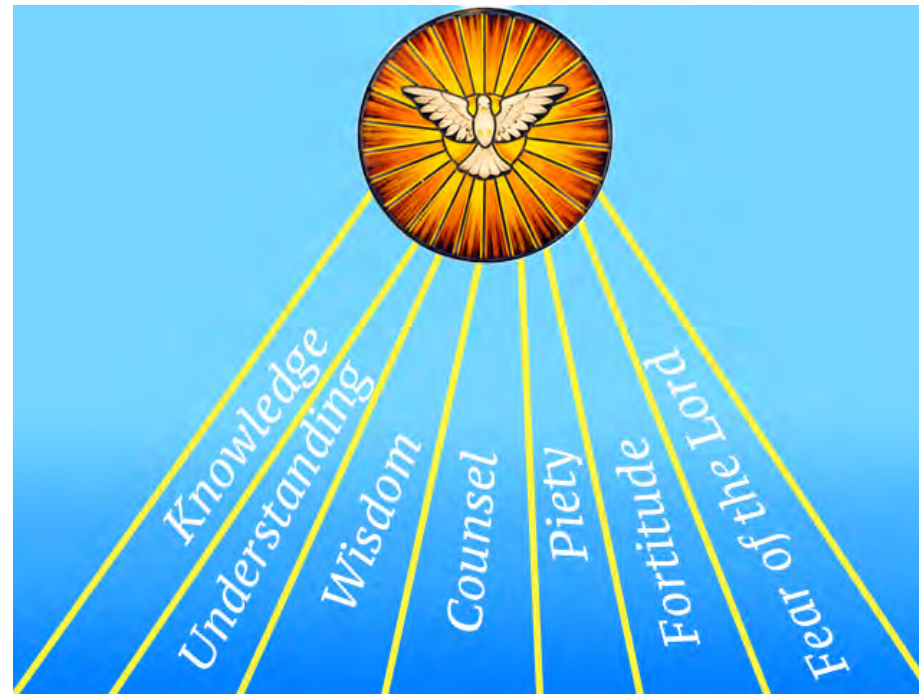

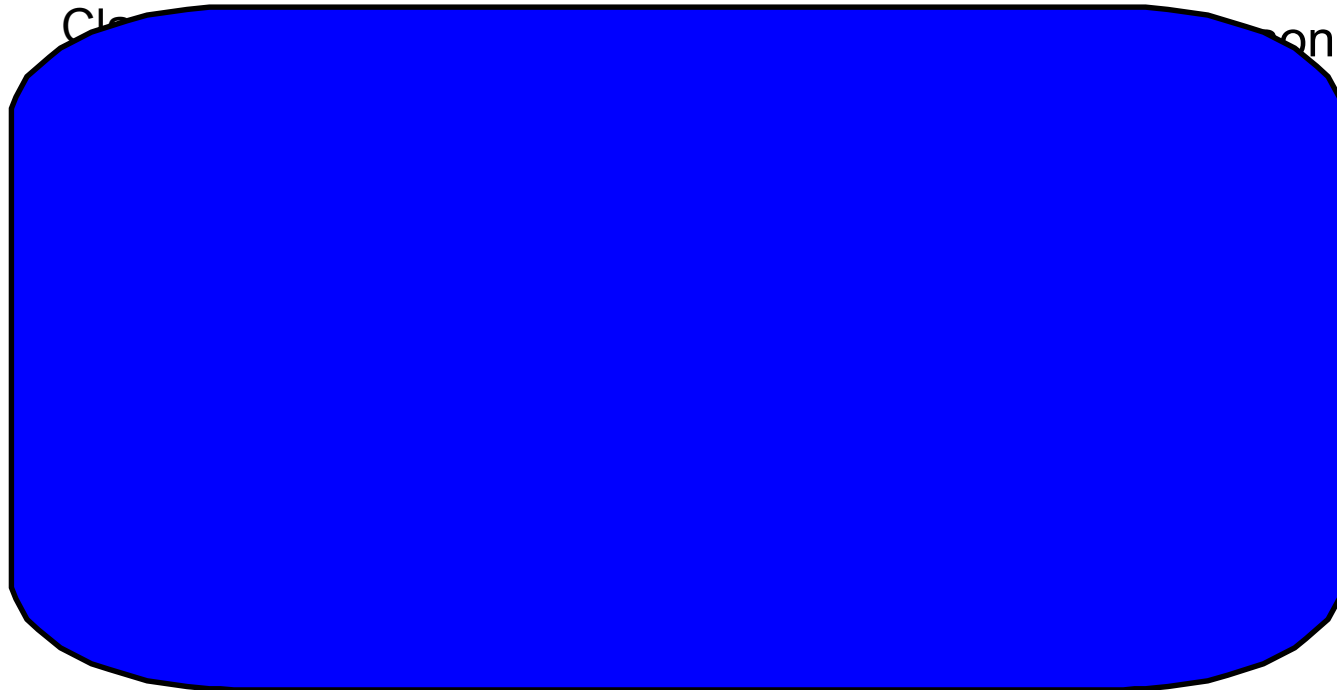

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit I

Name, define, and give examples of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Gift	Definition and Example
Wisdom	Helps us to see that the world is only a temporary place for us and that heaven is our true home. Examples for all will vary.
Understanding	Gives us an insight into the mysteries of faith and helps us to explain the Faith to others.
Knowledge	Helps us to see everything in life in relation to God and eternity, to know him, the world he created, and his plan for men.
Counsel	Helps us to make correct decisions about God's will for our lives.
Fortitude	Gives us the strength to be faithful to Christ even when it is difficult to do so.
Piety	Inspires us to worship God and to love him as our Father and to love our neighbor as ourself.
Fear of the Lord	Shows us the evil of sin and helps us to desire to live in God's grace. It is also called "wonder and awe" in God's presence.

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit

Name and define the fruits of the Holy Spirit.


Fruit	Definition
<u>Charity</u>	<u>Love for God and for others.</u>
<u>Joy</u>	<u>Happiness in living the Christian life.</u>
<u>Peace</u>	<u>Inner calmness, even in difficulties.</u>
<u>Patience</u>	<u>Bearing the difficulties of life with resignation to God's will.</u>
<u>Kindness</u>	<u>Sympathy and concern for the needs of others that moves us to help them.</u>
<u>Goodness</u>	<u>Giving good example in all that we do.</u>
<u>Generosity</u>	<u>Willingness to share our time and possessions with those in need.</u>
<u>Gentleness</u>	<u>Being gentle in our words and deeds with others.</u>
<u>Faithfulness</u>	<u>Loyalty to God and the people we are committed to, such as one's parents, spouse, and friends.</u>
<u>Modesty</u>	<u>Respecting ourselves and others in conversations, dress, etc.</u>
<u>Self-control</u>	<u>Proper balance in our desire for pleasure.</u>
<u>Chastity</u>	<u>Proper attitude toward others and control over our sexual desires.</u>
