
Samuel is born to Hannah,



Ch 1 **1 Samuel chapters 1-7**

- **Elkanah's wife Hannah is barren**
- **Hannah prays to God for a child**
- **She bears Samuel**
- **She offers Sam to God's service**

Ch2

Hannah's prayer = Mary's prayer

Eli ignores the sins of his sons

Eli and his sons are doomed

Ch3

Sam is woken up by God three times.

Eli "Speak Lord, your servant is listening."

- **Philistines steal the Ark**
- **Eli falls and breaks his neck**

Ch5

- **Phils put Ark in Temple of Dagon**
- **Statue of Dagon falls and breaks; plague of mice and tumors**

Samuel builds altar; offers sacrifice and becomes judge over the people

1 Samuel 8:10-18

- Why did the Hebrews want to be judged by a king?

the people wanted a King - the Israelites wanted to be like other pagan lands.

The people are rejecting God as their leader.

How will things be different with a king?

If the people had a King, -
the King will rule them; the people will have to give their best stuff to the King = taxes; will have to fight and die in the king's wars - sons and daughters will have to serve the king

Absolute Power corrupts absolutely - Kings quickly become corrupt

God grants their request

Joshua 24:15 - "As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD"

God has fulfilled his promises, will you?

Judges 21:25 - "In those days there was no king in Israel, everyone did what they thought was best."

God was King in Israel

1 Samuel 8:1-?

-The people request a king: They want to be like other nations (which have kings)

-"it is not you they reject, they are rejecting me as their king."

The rights of the King:

- 1) take your sons for his army
- 2) can make your sons farm and make weapons for him.
- 3) Daughters will become servants
- 4) Seize property and claim it for government
- 5) Seize crops
- 6) Take away servants and best animals
- 7) Flocks (sheep) and you yourself will become slaves

They would rather be like the rest of world:
POWER, HONOR, PLEASURE, MONEY

1 Samuel 8

The Israelites want Sam to give them a King

- they want to be like the other nations who have kings
- they are rejecting God as their King

The Rights of a King

- take their best animals
- use their daughters as bakers, ointment makers, & cooks
- you will become like slaves
- take best fields & give them to his officials
- Send your sons to war



1 Sam 9:14

Samuel's revelation about Saul

Saul is from the Tribe of Benjamin

He is extremely handsome

He is really tall and strong = a great soldier, who will deliver the Israelites from the Philistines

CHRISTOS

Hebrew: "MESSIAH" = "anointed one"

Samuel anoints Saul with oil and Saul becomes King of Israel






